Workshop Goals:

The goal of this workshop is to gather land managers and decision-makers to discuss options for managing resources in the face of climate change, and improve understanding of how vulnerability and adaptation information can be integrated into management and planning. Participants will develop climate-informed adaptation strategies and actions for priority habitats and ecosystem services (Day 1) and island-wide conservation activities (Day 2), and will leave with a prioritized list of actions that can be integrated into current and future management activities across agencies and organizations on the island of Kaua'i.

Workshop Objectives:

- 1. Provide participants with an overview of the vulnerability assessment results developed at the January 2017 workshop;
- 2. Evaluate and revise current management goals and actions given vulnerabilities;
- 3. Develop new climate-informed management actions designed to reduce vulnerabilities or increase resilience of habitats and ecosystem services;
- 4. Identify adaptation options for island-wide conservation activities; and
- 5. Prioritize climate-informed management actions including where and how to implement.
