National Adaptation Forum now accepting proposals and sponsors

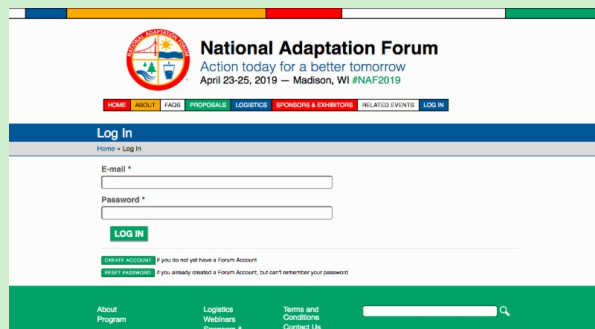
Call for Proposals opens TODAY!

Dig in to some fresh, new CAKE

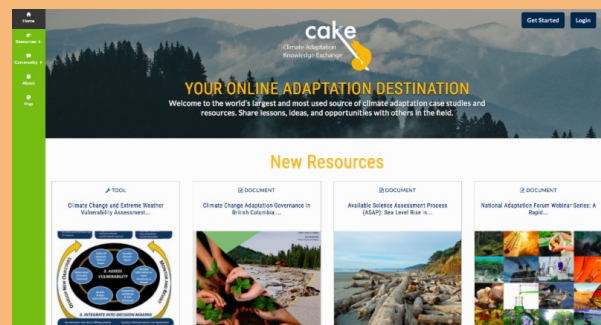
Drawing on feedback from the 2017 User Survey, the CAKE team launched a new and improved site last month!

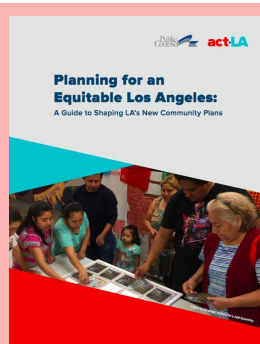


Equity at EcoAdapt

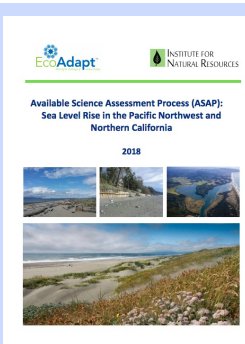


New Coastal and Marine Tools Available

Seas are rising and people need to know what to do about it. Our most recent **Available Science Assessment Process (ASAP)** identifies sea level rise-related adaptation

actions applied by resource managers, and evaluated the science behind those actions that may inform - if not improve - coastal planning and management in the Northwest.
